What Can I Recycle at the Curb?

- Glass bottles and jars of any color (please avoid breaking glass)
Glass must be separated from other material
- Aluminum cans
- Aluminum pie pans & aluminum foil (Ball all aluminum foil together into one large ball 2" or larger. No small, balled-up foil please.)
- Steel (tin) cans
- Metal jar lids
- Metal bottle caps
- Empty aerosol cans (no caps)
- Paper milk cartons/drink boxes/juice cartons
- Plastic bottles, jugs and tubs with a #1 -#7 on the bottom (Throw away caps & lids. No Styrofoam containers, no #7 PLA)
- Newspapers and newspaper inserts
- Corrugated cardboard* and brown paper bags
- Magazines & Catalogs
- Phone Books
- Larger Paperboard Items (such as cereal boxes, shoe boxes, large gift boxes, egg cartons, and paper 6 and 12-pack holders)
- toilet paper rolls, Office Paper/Opened Mail
- Paperback books (no hard-cover books)

- Shredded paper (please bag)
- PLASTIC BAGS grocery, newspaper, and bread bags. (please no zip lock bags or plastic wrapping)

* Corrugated Cardboard does not need to fit inside the bin - it can be securely placed outside your bin for collection.
